

## **Report of the activities undertaken as part of Gandhi Jayanti celebrations at ICAR-CPCRI, RS Kayamkulam on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2021**

To commemorate the 152<sup>nd</sup> birth anniversary of the Father of Nation-Mahatma Gandhi, and 117<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of former Prime Minister, Lal Bahadur Shastri, the celebrations at ICAR-CPCRI, Regional Station, Kayamkulam started with Swachhta Pledge administered by Dr. S. Kalavathi to all the staff members on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2021.
