### **About Kasaragod**









Kasaragod is the administrative headquarters of Kasaragod district in Kerala, India at 12.49° N, 74.98° E. It is the northernmost district of Kerala and is also known as Sapta Bhasha Sangama Bhumi ('The Land of Seven Languages'). Kasaragod, this hidden gem of the Malabar Coast has many tourist attractions in her bag to mesmerize you completely. Situated in the rich biodiversity of Western Ghats, it is known for the Chandragiri and Bekal Fort, Chandragiri River, historic Kolathiri Rajas, natural environment of Ranipuram and Kottancheri Hills, historical and religious sites like the Madiyan Kulom temple, Madhur Temple, Ananthapuram Lake Temple, and Malik Deenar Mosque. The historic hill of Ezhimala is located on the southern portion of Kavvayi Backwaters of Nileshwaram. Kasaragod is located on the estuary where the Chandragiri River empties into the Arabian Sea. Kasaragod is home to several forts, including Arikady Fort, Bekal Fort, Chandragiri Fort, and Hosdurg Fort. Bekal Fort is the largest fort in Kerala. Talakaveri, home to Talakaveri Wildlife Sanctuary where the 805 km long Kaveri river originates, is located closer to Ranipuram on the Kerala-Karnataka border.

#### Weather in Kasaragod:

Kasaragod experiences a tropical monsoon climate under the Köppen climate classification. It receives a generous 3,825 mm (150.6 in) of rain annually. The average temperature in Kasaragod in December for a typical day ranges from a high of 86°F (30°C) to a low of 74°F (23°C). The average time that the sky is clear or sunny (partly cloudy or less) in Kasaragod during December is 11.1 hours. In December, Kasaragod is moderately humid with an average amount of 66% (relative humidity), which could be described as sticky.

#### What to Wear?

With an average high of 86°F (30°C) and a low of 74°F (23°C), it generally feels very warm, sticky. With that in mind, most people would dress in something light like a sleeveless shirt.

#### **Travel information**

The nearest airport to Kasaragod is Mangalore (IXE) Airport, Karnataka which is 50 km away. Other nearby airports include Kannur (CNN) (90.2 km) and Calicut (CCJ) (185.1 km) both in Kerala. Railway line passes parallel to the coastal line. The city of Kasaragod has a railway station and there are many trains that ply from this place to other parts of the country. Almost all Express trains will stop in Kasaragod (KGQ) railway station. Kasaragod has a wide network of roads that connect it with the rest of Kerala and in a way, the whole of India. You can always hire cabs to reach this place by road
