

Brief History of ICAR-CPCRI, RS, Kayamkulam

- > 1882: Coconut palm disease was reported by farmers of Erattupetta after the great flood.
- > 1897: Farmers of Kaviyoor and Kalloopara complained about the coconut palm disease.
- > 1900: State of Travancore referred the petitions to Superintendent of Agricultural Farm, Karamana.
- > 1907: Mr. T.F. Bourdillion's concluded the disease to be of fungoidal origin.
- > 1908: Sir. E. J. Butler submitted a report titled 'Coconut palm disease in Travancore'.
- > 1916: Initiation of research on coconut started with establishment of four stations (three at Nileeshwar and one at Kudlu) under the Madras Presidency during 1916.
- > 1918: Department of Agriculture started one separate Mycology Section at Agricultural Research Laboratory (ARL), Kollam.
- > 1924: Mr. M.K. Varghese appointed as State Mycologist at ARL, Kollam and research work on coconut diseases initiated.
- > 1927: Mycology section shifted to Kayamkulam with a view to locate research in one of the areas worst affected by coconut diseases.
- > 1934: Book on 'Diseases of the Coconut Palm' by M.K. Varghese.
- > 1937: The scheme of investigations on the diseases of coconut was sanctioned with funding from Imperial Council of Agricultural Research and Dr. K. P. V. Menon was appointed at ARL, Kollam as Plant Pathologist to lead the project.
- > 1945: Indian Central Coconut Committee (ICCC) was constituted.
- > 1946: ICCC constituted a two member committee which recommended establishing two independent coconut stations one at Kasaragod and another at Kayamkulam.
- > 1947: The foundation stone for Central Coconut Research Station (CCRS), Kayamkulam was laid on 24.4.1947 by His Highness Sree Uthradom Thirunal Marthanda Varma, Elayaraja of the State of Travancore. Dr. K.P.V. Menon was put in charge of the station.
- > 1948: The scheme of investigations on the diseases of coconut was amalgamated with CCRS, Kayamkulam.
- > 1966: Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) took over the research stations (both at Kasaragod and Kayamkulam)
- > 1970: CCRS was renamed as CPCRI with headquarters at Kasaragod.
