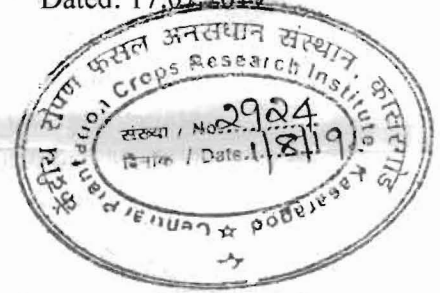

Sub:- Nomination of officers for the training program at NIPHM, Hyderabad – reg.

NIPHM, an autonomous organization under Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Government of India, aims to promote Bio intensive Plant Health Management stemming from the arising effects of indiscriminate use of agro chemicals.

As we are aware that indiscriminate pesticide usage in agriculture production is becoming an alarming issue across the world which needs to be addressed to protect our environment such as air, soil and water apart from our human health. When the pesticides are not applied properly, plant injury may occur and pest may not be controlled. A good spraying practice is important issue to be addressed and skill development on selection of appropriate application techniques needs to be taken up. To cater to the emerging training needs, NIPHM has proposed to organize an 8 day training programme on “**Good Agricultural Practices in Spraying**” from 23rd to 30th September 2019 under Model Training Courses (MTC). As it is under MTC training programme, there is a **restriction of 20 participants** only. Hence, the participants shall be confirmed on first cum first serve basis. Once the participation is confirmed from NIPHM, the officers are requested to strictly turn up to the training programme or else intimate the same at earliest so that the others may not miss this opportunity.

The concerned nominating authority is requested to provide the complete Officer details such Officer Name, Designation, Contact No and mail id for further communication.

In this regard, it is requested to kindly nominate 1-2 officials for above training programme being organized at NIPHM, Hyderabad.

MODEL TRAINING COURSE GOOD AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES IN SPRAYING

About NIPHM

National Institute of Plant Health Management (NIPHM) is a National level institute under the administrative control of the Department of Agriculture & Cooperation, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmer's welfare, Government of India established in the year 1966 as Central Plant Protection Institute (CPPTI) at Hyderabad. The Institute was rechristened subsequently as National Plant Protection Training Institute (NPPTI). It became an autonomous body in the year 2008 with the expanded scope of promoting environmentally sustainable Plant Health Management practices in diverse and changing agro-climatic conditions and Plant Biosecurity Management and Pesticide Management through capacity building programmes, besides providing inputs for policy formulation on Plant Health Management, Plant Biosecurity, Invasive Alien Species, market access, Pesticide Management etc. at state and national level.

Being a premier institute in the country working on capacity building in the area of plant protection, NIPHM is training the officers/ Scientists of Central and State Government in Plant Health Management, Plant Biosecurity, Pesticide Management, Plant Health Engineering and Vertebrate and Urban Pest Management. NIPHM also conducts training to private industry/ pest control operators in fumigation, urban pest management, heat treatment etc.

BACKGROUND

Sustainable plant health management is important in current agrarian scenario and key issue of global developments with regards to food safety, food security, environment and biodiversity preservation as well as protection. The dynamics of plant diseases and pests coupled with invasive pests are changing mainly due to climatic change. Managing the pests and diseases has become a huge challenge. Many incidences such as Endosulfan spray in Kerala and Yavatmal incidence at Maharashtra has dazed our country in improper spraying practices. Good practices for spraying can be a fruitful solution for spray operators/ farmers. This training programme mainly aims to highlight the proper selection of spray technique, nozzle, recommended dose of application for target area, safety measures and care and maintenance of sprayer for overall doubling the farmers income by effective utilization.

BOARDING AND LODGING

Free lodging and boarding will be provided to the participants in the Institute's Hostel at Rajendranagar, Hyderabad as per NIPHM norms. The participants should abide by the rules and regulations of the Institute. Participants are requested not to bring their family members due to limited accommodation facility.

TRAVEL

TA/ DA of participants from ICAR/ SAU/ KVK may be borne by their respective organization/ institute. However TA (limited to II AC) will be paid to officers from line departments of State governments.

HOW TO REACH NIPHM

The Institute can be reached by APSRTC bus from Secunderabad Rly Stn. by Bus No 5/92 Directly or by Nos 5, 5K, 5M or 49M to Mehdipatnam and from there by 92, 92R, 92S, 92N, 92E or 251 to NIPHM. One can reach the Institute from Hyderabad Rly station by bus No. 92R (frequency is less). Bus No. 94R, 94H, 94K or 194H from Koti plys via NIPHM. Hyderabad International Airport is located about 15 kms from NIPHM. Buses from Airport to Secunderabad passes via Dairy Farm/ PDP from where NIPHM is just at walkable Distance.
