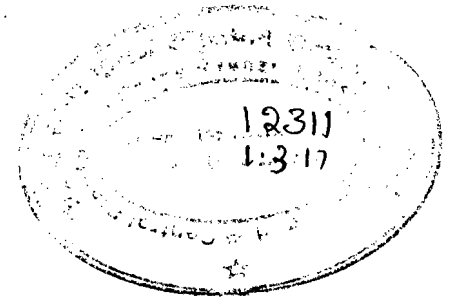


Sir,
